Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting \$2,279,680.00 for the Town of Grifton to construct a new elevated potable water storage tank to improve pressure stabilization and enhance water quality management within the Town's public drinking water system.

There is a strong federal nexus as this project supports the purposes of the Safe Drinking Water Act, which authorizes federal assistance for improvements to public drinking water infrastructure that protects public health and ensures the delivery of safe potable water.

The proposed construction of a new elevated water storage tank will improve pressure stabilization within the Town of Grifton's drinking water distribution system and enhance water quality management by reducing water age and preventing stagnation through the use of a tank mixing system. These improvements will support reliable system operations and help maintain safe drinking water for residents and businesses served by the Town's public water distribution and storage system.

The project is eligible under the State and Tribal Assistance Grants (STAG) account for drinking water infrastructure improvements administered by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency.
