Dear Congressman Murphy:


On behalf of the City of Greenville, I respectfully request your support for \$1,498,982 in Community Project Funding for the Greenbriar Flood Mitigation and Stream Restoration Project. This investment will eliminate a critical drainage chokepoint in the Greens Mill Run watershed, deliver 10-year level-of-service flood protection to area residents, and directly protect vulnerable households.

The Greens Mill Run watershed has experienced chronic, damaging flooding for decades. In 2016, the City completed a comprehensive Watershed Master Plan that ranked the Greenbriar project among its highest priorities. The project is fully designed and permitted and is ready to proceed to construction upon receipt of funding.

Federal investment in this project is an investment in the people in North Carolina's 3rd Congressional District who are least equipped to absorb the cost of flood damage and displacement. Without this funding, the construction phase cannot move forward, and the watershed's foundational drainage problem will remain unaddressed indefinitely — exposing residents to continued flood risk and blocking the City's ability to implement the remainder of the Greens Mill Run improvement program.

The City of Greenville has a strong track record of managing federal investments responsibly and has successfully navigated the design, permitting, and acquisition phases of this project. We are positioned to obligate and expend federal construction funds efficiently upon award. Thank you for your leadership on behalf of Eastern North Carolina and for your consideration of this request.
