- 1. Admission to a U.S. Service Academy is more than a college program and degree, it is the start of military career with a service obligation. What is your intended service branch/warfare area? Explain why you are choosing the branch in addition to explaining your understanding of the duties for a junior officer in that area.
- 2. U.S. Service Academy appointments are extremely competitive with about 5% of applicants receiving an appointment. Considering this statistic, explain what your plans are if you do not receive an appointment to an Academy. If your plans involve reapplying, explain measures you would take during the following year to become a competitive applicant.
- 3. Military structure includes detailed responsibilities and deadlines. In your opinion, how should an application submitted that does not conform to the stated requirements be handled? How should an application that is submitted after the stated deadline be handled, as well? Describe a situation where you held yourself or someone else accountable in a position of responsibility to date.

VI. Three Recommendation Letters:

A teacher, a coach and a person (unrelated to you) must provide a typed recommendation letter with their wet/authentic signature provided at bottom of letter and across the flap of the sealed envelope. Refer to page 5.

VII. Academic Records:

- Include a sealed official transcript from all high schools, community colleges, or colleges you have attended prior to October 1, 2023 with your complete packet. The high school transcript must include your class rank.
- Include official SAT scores if they are not noted on your official academic transcript.

VIII. Applicant's Signature:

I am a United States citizen or will be by the time I enter the Academy. I am at least 17 years old, but not yet 23 years old on July 1st of admission year to an Academy.
