Pick one and discuss what steps you took to address it. Include whether you turned to anyone, the role that person played, and what you learned about your character as a result of that challenge.
- Describe what led to your initial interest in the United States Military and how a U.S. Service Academy will help you achieve your long-range goals. Describe a personal experience you have had which you feel has contributed to your own character development and integrity.
- 3. An appointment to a U.S. Service Academy is more than attending a prestigious scholastic academy, as you will be committing to serve for six years in your chosen career path. Explain your specific career aspirations and what you know about the duties and preparations it will take to fulfill that obligation.

VI. Three Recommendation Letters:

A teacher, a coach and a person (unrelated to you) must provide a typed recommendation letter, refer to page 5.

VII. Academic Records:

- Include a <u>sealed</u> official transcript from all high schools, community colleges, or colleges you have attended prior to October 1, 2025 with your complete packet.
- Request testing service to send an official copy of your scores electronically to Congressman Murphy's office before the 10/01/25 deadline date. Use NC-03 ACT code: <u>7581</u> and SAT code: <u>5916</u>
- **PLEASE NOTE:** If your scores are not received by deadline date (10/01), your application packet will be considered incomplete.
